

Car Auction Guidelines and Fee Structure

- All vehicles are sold 'as is/ where is" with no warranties.
 - All bidders must present a valid driver's license and a **\$100.00 cash** deposit to obtain a number.
 - There is a \$10.00 fee charged for temporary tags. **Tags are issued for 30 days only; Goodwill will not reissue temp-tags if you fail to pass the car through inspection during this 30 days.**
 - There is a \$10.00 administrative fee charged for each vehicle purchased.
 - All winning bidders must show proof of current automobile insurance to purchase a vehicle and be at **least 18 years old**. (driver's license and proof of insurance must correspond to the purchaser)
 - All vehicles purchased must be paid for on the day of auction. All paperwork must be completed within 24 hours.
 - If multiple vehicles are purchased, **all** of those vehicles must be paid in full before any vehicle can be taken off of the lot.
 - Any bidder not paying for his/her vehicle will forfeit his/her deposit and the vehicle will be resold in the next car auction. Bidding privileges will then be suspended.
 - Payment may be made with cash, Master Card, Visa or Discover. We do not accept personal checks.
 - We do not allow any vehicle repairs or vehicle maintenance on Goodwill property.
 - All vehicles must be removed from Goodwill property by the Monday morning following the auction.
 - Any vehicle left on Goodwill property on Monday morning following auction, will be towed to a storage facility owned and operated by Ewing's Towing. Each vehicle towed will incur a \$75.00 towing fee and a \$25.00 a day storage fee payable to Ewing's Towing. Buyer will not be notified by Ewing's Towing and should consider this as proper notification.
 - Goodwill Industries assumes no liability for damages sustained to the vehicle after purchase.
 - Buyer is responsible for DMV inspection, registration and title acquisition. Bidding privileges will be suspended if a purchased vehicle is ticketed or abandoned before car is registered with DMV.
 - Management reserves the right to remove any vehicle, at any time, from the current auction.
 - If you are a dealer and you purchase one or more vehicles, the vehicle(s) will be titled with the name of the dealership, and the dealership will be responsible for any applicable state sales tax. You may not send someone else to Goodwill to have their name placed on the title as a way of avoiding sales tax.
- **Bid fixing/rigging/intimidating will not be tolerated. Management reserves the right to remove any person thought to be displaying any behavior we deem as inappropriate.**
